

Re: Connecticut Husky B and Charter Oak

A Level of Care (LOC) is required for both Husky B and Charter Oak payment types. In the Level of Care tool, please utilize the drop down box for the payment source to select either HUSKY B or Charter Oak (See screen print below). The hospitals and the nursing facilities both have the ability to submit the LOC; however the nursing facility is ultimately responsible for ensuring that a LOC is submitted. With each admission of a Husky B or Charter Oak client, an admit notice (352) is required to be submitted by the nursing facility along with the subsequent discharge notice (353) if applicable. If the payment source changes to Medicaid a new LOC and admission notice need to be submitted.
